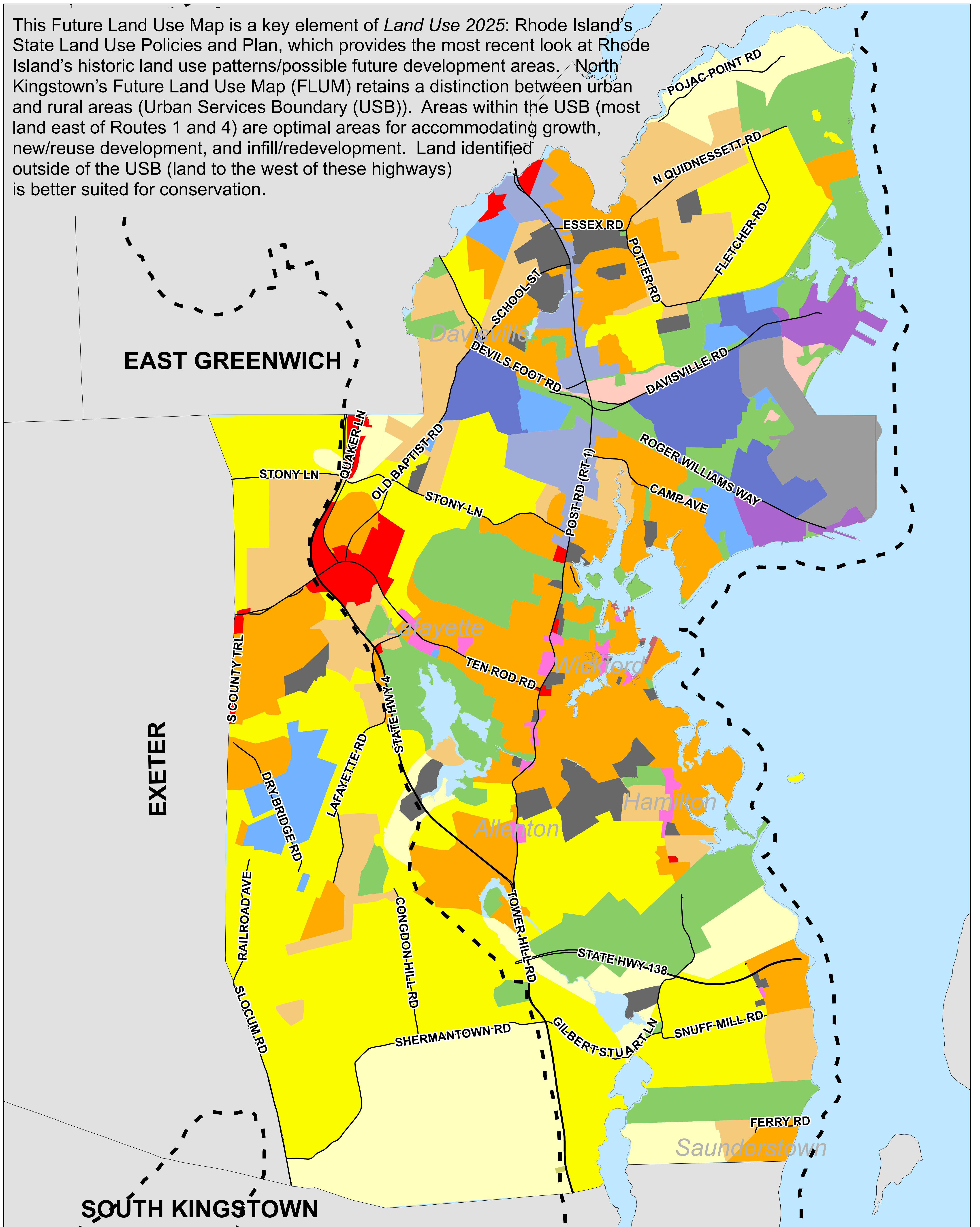


This Future Land Use Map is a key element of *Land Use 2025: Rhode Island's State Land Use Policies and Plan*, which provides the most recent look at Rhode Island's historic land use patterns/possible future development areas. North Kingstown's Future Land Use Map (FLUM) retains a distinction between urban and rural areas (Urban Services Boundary (USB)). Areas within the USB (most land east of Routes 1 and 4) are optimal areas for accommodating growth, new/reuse development, and infill/redevelopment. Land identified outside of the USB (land to the west of these highways) is better suited for conservation.
