MAY 30 MEMORIAL DAY COMMEMORATIVE

9 AM CEREMONIES TO KICK-OFF TRADITIONAL HONORS

The North Kingstown commemoration of Memorial Day will begin at 9AM, Monday, May 30 with wreath laying ceremonies on the grounds of Veterans Memorial Park which sits across the way from the town hall located at 80 Boston Neck Road (Rte. 1A) for the purpose of paying homage to those lost in the nation's armed conflicts.

ANNUAL PARADE SLATED FOR 10AM

The parade will start at 10am with the route following West Main, Brown, and Phillips Streets through Wickford village and onto Tower Hill Road (Rte. 1) to the Grand Army of the Republic Memorial on the grounds of Elm Grove Cemetery for the concluding ceremonies which are expected to begin at 11AM.
